Call for Abstract

Guidlines for Abstract Submission

Author(s) are requested to send their abstract, not exceeding 200 words, in font size 12, Times Roman, 1.5 line spacing and margin of 2.5cm (1inch). A maximum of five keywords. Ensure the Abstract is original and free from plagiarism.

Guidlines for Full Length Paper

The paper should be original and presented for the first time. Paper should be compiled in the following order: title page; abstract; keywords; main text introduction, materials and methods, results, discussion; acknowledgments; declaration of interest statement; references; table(s) with caption(s) (on individual pages); figures; figure captions (as a list).

· The number of pages should be limited to 6.

· Use Times Roman 12 font size with 1.5-line spacing and for title 14 font size.

· Each paper will be given 10 minutes for a PowerPoint presentation.

· A maximum of 4 authors is allowed per paper.

Publication will be in ISBN.
