Sub: Regarding Conduct of Entrance Examination for Post Graduate Allied and Healthcare Programmes.

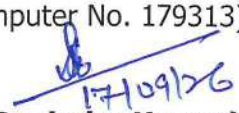
University is going to conduct the entrance Examination for admission in Post Graduate Allied and Healthcare Programmes for the academic session 2026-2027. University has decided to establish Examination Centre at all affiliated colleges/campus, where Postgraduate Allied and Healthcare Programmes are running.

In this regard, following is brought to your kind notice:

1. The entrance exam will be conducted on **September 23, 2026 (i.e. Wednesday)**.
2. Eligibility for the entrance exam will strictly as per the NCAHP guidelines.
3. The institutes or campuses must post the entrance examination notice on their respective websites.
4. The duration of the entrance exam is 90 minutes.
5. The passing marks will be set at 40%.
6. A question paper/answer sheets comprising 100 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) for the relevant disciplines will be provided by university via email 30 minutes prior to the start of the exam.
7. Answer sheets will be evaluated by the respective institutes.
8. The results will be prepared on the basis of merit in the entrance exam. The results must be declared on the same day and submitted to the university in a sealed envelope.
9. Local Controller/ Superintendent/ Evaluator/ Invigilator/ other staff must be deputed by the respective institutes or campuses at their own expenses.
10. The university reserves the right to appoint a flying squad to oversee the conduct of the entrance exam.
11. The detailed instructions will be issued separately.

Please note that these complete details and documents must be submitted to the university on or **before 25.09.2026 (Friday)**. Any delay in submission will be viewed seriously as it directly impacts the NCAHP guidelines issued from time to time. The colleges will be solely responsible for the smooth conduct of entrance examination at their respective institutes.

Instructions for COLLEGES regarding Entrance Examination for admission in PG Courses (Allied and Healthcare) for academic session 2026-27.

University will conduct an Entrance Examination for admission to PG Programmes in Allied Health Care Courses. In this regard, colleges are advised to go through the following instructions:

1. The Exam will be held on 23-09-2026 (Wednesday).
2. Colleges will appoint a Local Controller, Superintendent, and other staff as per requirements. The details of the Local Controllers and Superintendent including their email IDs and mobile numbers will be shared with the university on or before 22.09.2026 by 11:00 AM. The University will share the Google sheet in this regard.
3. Colleges must ensure proper internet connectivity and electricity backup for the smooth conduct of the entrance exam.
4. The Entrance Exam will be held strictly under the CCTV surveillance, and recording must be kept until the batch (2026) passes out.
5. No TA/DA or any honorarium will be paid by the university.
6. University will share the soft copy of entrance examination forms, admit card, and attendance sheet.
7. College can accept the entrance examination form on or before 21.09.2026. Colleges must share the list of students appearing for the exam with the university through email at admissioncell@ptu.ac.in on or before 22.09.2026 by 11:00 AM.
8. The Question paper will be shared with the Local Controller through email at least half an hour before the start of the examination.
9. The Invigilation staff must ensure proper frisking of the students to avoid unfair means cases.
10. No invigilation staff is allowed to carry any electronic device into the examination hall.
11. Colleges must display the instructions for students on their notice board and college website.
12. Colleges must issue admit cards after assigning the six-digit roll number. The first three digits of the roll number will be the college code, and next three digit will starts from 101 onwards. For example, if the college code is 10 then the roll numbers will be 010101, 010102, 010103 and so on.
13. Local Controller's will also be responsible for the evaluation of the answer sheets. Evaluation must be conducted strictly under CCTV surveillance, and the recording must be retained at the college level until the batch (2026) passes out.
14. Evaluation is to be carried out on the same day.
15. University will share the answer key with the Local Controller at 1:30 PM through email and start the evaluation process immediately.
16. The colleges will display the results of the qualified students on their respective notice board / website in order of merit. A copy of the result must be sent to the university through email (admissioncell@ptu.ac.in) on the same day.
17. Local Controller / Superintendent shall be solely responsible for the smooth conduct of entrance examination and declaration of the result.
18. The syllabus for Entrance Exam will be based on the qualifying graduation level course. (For example: the syllabus for students seeking admission to the Master of Anaesthesia and Operation Theatre Technology Programme will be that of B.AOTT).
19. Question paper will comprised of 100 MCQ-type questions. Each question will carry 1 mark.
20. Duration of the examination will be 90 minutes. The Entrance Exam will start at 11:00 AM.
21. Students must fill out the entrance Examination Form at the institute where they seek admission on or before 21.09.2026.
22. There is no fee for appearing in the entrance exam.
23. There will be no negative marking.

24. Students must secure a minimum of 40% marks to qualify for the entrance exam.
25. Students must tick the appropriate option (with Black/ Blue Pen only) in the question paper itself.
26. If two or more options are ticked by the student(s), then that question will not be evaluated.
27. If answers are ticked with a pencil, those questions will not be evaluated.
28. Mere qualifying the entrance exam will not guarantee a seat for admission.
29. Admissions will be made solely on the basis of merit in the Entrance Examination.
30. Students are not allowed to carry any electronic devices with them into the Examination Centre.
31. Students will be automatically disqualified if any electronic device is found on him/her during search by the invigilation staff.
32. If a student is found using any unfair means during the entrance exam, the candidature of such candidates will be considered cancelled.
33. Students are supposed to report to the examination centre at least half an hour before the start of the examination.
