

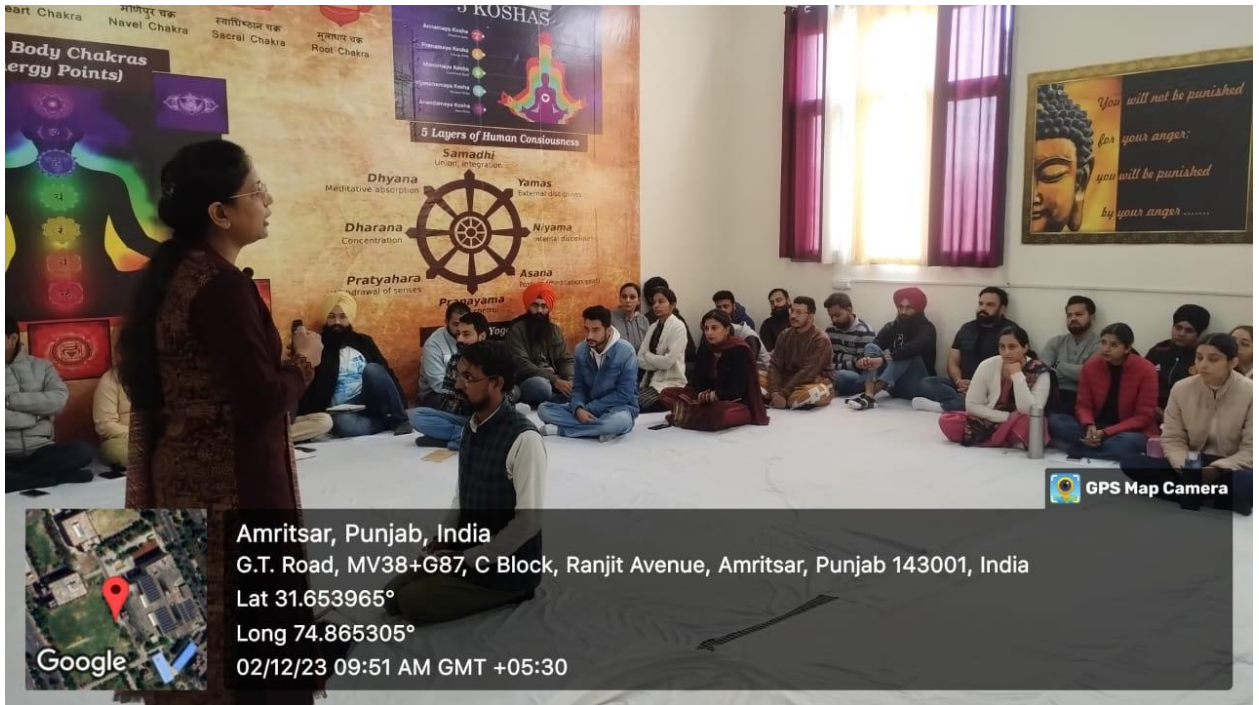
## **AICTE Approved 3 Days Faculty Development Program on Universal Human Values at Khalsa College of Engineering and Technology**
